**Appellation:** Kunsági, Hungary

**Characteristics:**  
Low in tannins with a pronounced spicy character. Rich fruity flavors of wild blackberries and raspberries.

**Food pairing:**  
Tomato and basil pizza, roasted meats or grilled vegetables.

### Description:

Hungary is a brilliant, but small land-locked nation almost divided in half by the Danube River. Located on the same latitude as the renowned Burgundy region of France, the climate here is more continental with hot summers and long, sunny autumn days – perfect growing conditions for sweet, ripe grapes to flourish. Our Budaherz hails from the Kunsági area, found on the Alföld (great Hungarian plain) with its sun-drenched soils.

To some extent, Blaufränkisch shares some traits with the Gamay grape (think Beaujolais Nouveau) with which it has sometimes been confused. Both grapes make a light, quaffable, and distinguished red wine, that is oftentimes crafted into more complex, slightly-ageable wines like our Budaherz. The grape is also known as Lemberger which points to its origin on the Danube as it comes from the town of Limberg in the Austro-Hungarian empire which is now Slovenia.

Budaherz works extremely well at the dinner table, especially with meats. It also complements simpler fare like hamburgers or pizza. Pastas are a terrific match as the acidity is present to pair with rich, creamy sauces or balance with tomato sauces. As a sweet red wine with soft tannins, you can serve slightly chilled or at room temperature. Best of all, serve with family and friends! It's a terrific crowd-pleaser.
